- Recharter on or before the District recharter day
- Submit a Unit Godsend Award Nominee at Recharter
- Hold a scheduled Committee Meeting at least quarterly (4 times a year)
- Hold a Scout recruitment event
- Have an adult assigned and active for Training Coordinator
- Have an adult assigned and active for Advancement Coordinator
- Have an adult assigned and active for Health and Safety Advisor
- Request a Den Chief from your local Boy Scout Troop – Specify Troop _____
